Angelica and Lorraine,

Following are responses to each of the concerns you've raised and our proposed next steps:

1. Speed on 12<sup>th</sup> St NW making it difficult for resident and commercial traffic to turn from Aspen Ave NW, Bellamah Ave NW, and Sawmill Rd NW.  
**We will ask that DMD/Traffic Engineering review this intersection, including warrants for a traffic signal, and make recommendations.**
2. Speed on Bellamah and 18<sup>th</sup> Street-the turn located just south of the SCLT-The Artisan Apartment is a very dangerous location and will only get worse with incoming development.  
**We are working on a plan for Bellamah streetscape from Rio Grande Blvd to 18<sup>th</sup> Street and will look at traffic calming options as part of that effort.**
3. Cut-through traffic and speed on Sawmill Rd NW from 12<sup>th</sup> Street NW to Mountain Rd NW

The improvements at 12<sup>th</sup> & Sawmill were just completed in Oct/Nov last year. We will ask DMD/Traffic Engineering to do a follow-up study to determine the extent to which cut-through and speed has been reduced.

4. Intersection of Aspen Ave NW and Rio Grande Blvd NW. With speed and traffic backing up on Rio Grande, it is almost impossible to turn off of Aspen, especially doing a left turn/heading south on Rio Grande.

The Rio Grande Blvd Complete Street Plan addresses this intersection. You can look at what has been proposed here: [Rio Grande Complete Street Concept Plan](#). Councilor Benton secured \$750,000 in the capital budget for the 2017 GO bond cycle to begin implementation of the master plan, but there are currently no funds for engineering and construction of the improvements at this intersection. This will continue to be a priority in the '19 GO bond program.

- RAKS Building Supply has traffic entering and leaving their business

Please clarify the concern/request. All businesses have traffic entering and leaving. What is the specific concern or issue caused by this?

- Laun-Dry has semis blocking the view of North coming traffic (which speed with 30 MPH sign). I did see a speed trailer set up on 12th Street between Aspen and Bellamah. Would like to know its analysis on speeders.

We'll request the speed data from the trailers.

- UPS has their fleet trucks piling up to exit Aspen (takes a while to get your turn to leave the community plus the stress of trying to not get crashed into going Northbound - I travel with two children, by the way.

We will ask DMD/Traffic Engineering to review the intersection, including warrants for a traffic signal, and make recommendations.
